

Delta County Hires Veteran Services Officer

The Delta County Veteran Affairs Office will be closed for the holidays due to the retirement of Veteran Services Officer Ann Roman. The office will reopen during the month of January on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9:00 A.M – 2:00 P.M with a temporary Veteran Services Officer. Beginning on February 1st, the office will initiate a joint agreement with the UPWARD Talent Council to establish full-time hours with its new Veteran Services Officer, David Dziejwior.

David is a retired United States Navy Chief Petty Officer with twenty years of service.
