I. PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to assure a uniform standard for the procedure of roadside garbage, debris.

II. MANAGEMENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Management will advise the caller or the reporting person of the policy and procedure of this Road Commission in relation to Road Side Garbage Clean up and or Dumping.
- B. Each Supervisor shall effectively enforce compliance of this policy.

III. EMPLOYEE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- A. Employees shall comply with this policy
- B. Employees shall consult with his/her supervisor or other management personnel whenever there is a question regarding this or any other policy.

IV. POLICY:

Due to the increased cost of Labor, Equipment, Fuel, and Dumping Fees, liability issues, and the continued decline of revenue, the Delta County Road Commission will no longer clean up Road-Side garbage, dumping of appliances and/or furniture, tires, metal, or any other object or material dumped by citizens along any County Road. The Delta County Road Commission will not promote, participate, or supply materials to any agency wishing to pick-up garbage within the Right of Way of any and all County Roads.

V. POLICY EXCEPTIONS:

1. Exception for the pick up of the adopt-a-highway bags along the State highways during the program dates.
2. Exception for Road Killed Deer please refer to policy #18 in the Delta County Road Commission Policy Manual.
3. Exception for pick-up is if the debris or garbage is in the traveled portion of a road and is a road safety hazard.
