APPROVAL OR DISAPPROVAL
OF AMENDATORY ACT TO
REDUCE STATE USE TAX AND
REPLACE WITH A LOCAL
COMMUNITY STABILIZATION
SHARE TO MODERNIZE THE
TAX SYSTEM TO HELP SMALL
BUSINESSES GROW AND
CREATE JOBS

The amendatory act adopted by
the Legislature would:

1. Reduce the state use tax and replace with a local community stabilization share of the tax for the purpose of modernizing the tax system to help small businesses grow and create jobs in Michigan.
2. Require Local Community Stabilization Authority to provide revenue to local governments dedicated for local purposes, including police safety, fire protection, and ambulance emergency services.
3. Increase portion of state use tax dedicated for aid to local school districts.
4. Prohibit Authority from increasing taxes.
5. Prohibit total use tax rate from exceeding existing constitutional 6% limitation.

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Brampton Township, Delta County, imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution, of 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for a period of 10 years, 2015 to 2024 inclusive, for operation, equipment, and maintenance of the Township Fire Department.

The estimated revenue generated from the one (1) mill that will be collected in the first year that the millage is authorized and levied will be \$25,060.95.
