The estimated revenue generated from the six-tenths (0.6) mil that will be collected in the first year that the millage is authorized and levied will be \$63,354.67.

**BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT BOND PROPOSAL**

Shall the City of Gladstone, County of Delta, Michigan, borrow the principal sum of not to exceed Two Million Three Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$2,350,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds, in one or more series, payable in not to exceed twenty (20) years from the date of issuance of each series, for the purpose of paying the cost to (a) remodel, furnish, expand and equip the existing city hall building, (b) remodel, furnish, expand and equip the existing public works building or acquire, construct, furnish and equip a new public works building, and (c) acquire, furnish and equip heavy equipment for the public works department?

The estimated millage to be levied in 2016 is 1.860 mills (\$1.86 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and the estimated simple average annual millage rate required to retire the bonds is 1.860 mills (\$1.86 per \$1,000 of taxable value).
