Shall the currently authorized millage rate of 1.9 mills (\$1.90 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) which may be assessed against all property in Big Bay de Noc School District, Delta and Schoolcraft Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2018 to 2027, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2018 is approximately \$299,520 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2017 tax levy)?  <b>YES</b> <input type="radio"/> <b>NO</b> <input type="radio"/>
