**DATA Millage Request**

Shall the Delta Area Transit Authority, as provided for by Public Act 196, levy a new millage in order to provide demand response and other related services for the elderly, persons with disabilities, the disadvantaged, and other members of the general public in Bark River Township, of up to 0.5 mil (\$0.50 on each \$1,000 of State Taxable Value) on all property for a period of five (5) years, 2018 through 2022, inclusive, to provide services for Bark River Township to participate in Delta Area Transit Authority's Transportation?

The estimated revenue generated from five-tenths (0.5) mil that will be collected in the first year that the millage is authorized and levied will be \$19,510.00.
